## Annual Dues and Religious School Tuition

July 2009

Dear Temple Beth Torah Member,

Enclosed please find your Temple Beth Torah invoice for Temple Dues, Building Fund (if applicable) and Religious School Fees for the year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, plus any outstanding amount owed from the previous fiscal year. Given the difficult economic times for many the Temple Board has voted not to increase either dues or tuition for the coming year. In order to maintain the financial health of the Temple it will be necessary for us to manage our expenses very carefully in the coming year.

Temple Beth Torah has an annual budget based on projected revenue from members' dues and tuition. Each month we have to meet payroll and facilities related financial obligations. In order to meet these financial obligations we must have consistent and predictable monthly payments from our membership to cover these costs. We offer a number of payment options and financial aid for those who qualify. At this time we request that you select an option for 2009-2010 membership and tuition payments. By selecting an option we can all plan to meet our financial obligations.

- **Temple dues and school tuition (less financial aid award, if applicable) paid in full within 30 days of receipt of invoice**
- **Two payments by credit card or check (due September 1 and February 1) each for half of the annual obligation (less financial aid award, if applicable)**
- **Quarterly payments by credit card or check (the total amount due to be charged to a credit card or by check divided into 4 equal payments due August 1, November 1, February 1, May 1, less financial award, if applicable)**
- **Monthly payments whereby each payment is 1/10<sup>th</sup> of your total obligation for the year. Payments would begin August 2009 and be completed by May 2010 (less financial aid award, if applicable). You may use an automatic credit card payment (see credit card authorization below) or pay monthly by check. *Monthly payments by check are due no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.***

**The credit card authorization must be submitted each year.**

Temple Beth Torah has a number of policies that we would like to highlight.

- You must be a member in good standing (all previous years' financial obligations met) in order to receive High Holiday Seats and to enroll your child in religious school.
- If you have a B'nai Mitzvah during this year, the policy requires that all outstanding bills (including Religious School for all members of your family) be paid in full at least one month prior to the event or be fully guaranteed with monthly credit card payments.

Temple Beth Torah is dedicated to providing a place of worship and education to all Jewish families in our community. If you are unable to meet these financial requirements, you may discuss this confidentially with Reva Tankle, our Finance Chair. **Please be aware that it is your responsibility to contact us regarding your payment obligation.
